

"IT IS CALDILLO DE MARISCOS."





Birth date: March 9th 1454

Death date: February 22<sup>nd</sup> 1498

Nationality: Italian

Main voyages and things discovered:

On his third and most successful voyage, he discovered present-day Rio de Janeiro and Rio de la Plata. Believing he had discovered a new continent, he called South America the New World.

Legacy:

Vespucci's historical importance may rest more with his letters than his discoveries. Within a few years of the publication of his two letters, the European Republic became aware of the newly discovered continents of the Americas.

Fun Fact:

Amerigo Vespucci met and conversed with Christopher Columbus in 1496.

Main voyages and things discovered:

Ferdinand Magellan's expedition in 1522 was the first to circumnavigate the Earth, completing one of the most ambitious feats of exploration at the time.

Legacy:

In search of fame and fortune, Portuguese explorer Ferdinand Magellan set out from Spain in 1519 with a fleet of five ships to discover a western sea route to the Spice Islands.

Fun Fact:

Many of the sailors were Spanish and did not trust Magellan because he was Portuguese.

# WHAT DID I LEARN IN THIS PROJECT?


